Open	Aged 18 or above	

- Late submissions (according to postal chop for submission by mail) will not be considered.
- All submitted materials will not be returned.
- Winning drawings may be used by the organizers for exhibition, publication, broadcasting or other publicity purposes.
- The champions of the three Hong Kong groups will compete with champions from Guangdong and Macao for the cross-boundary overall champions of the 2010 Guangdong – Hong Kong – Macao Chinese White Dolphin Drawing Competition.
