<u>Invitation to join the "No Straw Campaign" – Plastic-free Living Week</u> <u>proudly presented by Ocean Park Conservation Foundation, Hong Kong (OPCFHK)</u>

Since the launch of the "No Straw Campaign" in 2018, Ocean Park Conservation Foundation, Hong Kong ("OPCFHK") aims to encourage the public to minimise the use of disposable plastic straws and other plastics in Hong Kong, taking a significant step towards safeguarding our marine eco-system. In order to further promote the "plastic-free culture", OPCFHK is running the campaign through schools from primary to secondary level with the new "Plastic-free Living Week" this year. Participating schools will be provided with the activity kit designed by OPCFHK or schools may custom-made their own materials so as to raise the awareness of threats caused by marine debris and to take action in conservation.

Marine debris is now an imminent problem. Appearing in various forms and sources, marine debris affects marine creatures in all scales (from planktons to blue whale) and humans as plastic enters the food chain as microplastics. Surveys have revealed that 95% of marine debris found in Hong Kong waters comes from local sources, 80% of which is plastic (e.g. disposable plastic-ware and packaging etc.). Every year, countless marine animals suffer from intestinal blockage, malnutrition, and mistaken plastic ingestion leading to death. Plastic pollution requires ongoing research effort to seek solutions; however, an effective way to resolve this problem is to make small behavioural changes in our daily life – to reduce single-use plastic consumption.

Hong Kong is a fast-paced city which results in high consumption of disposables. With forgoing disposable straws as the first step, OPCFHK believes that we can all work together to strive for a plastic-free lifestyle. "No Straw Campaign" encourages the public to establish the habit of sustainable living without using plastic straws through a series of educational talks and the annual celebration of "No Straw Day" on 8 June. Together we protect our ocean and marine animals.

OPCFHK cordially invites all local primary and secondary schools to join our "No Straw Campaign" to promote the "Plastic-Free Living Week". All participating schools will be enlisted on the official website of OPCFHK to acknowledge your effort and contribution in conservation.
